FOREWORD

Dato' Dr. Tan Chee Khuan / 10.2014



I first met Mr Ch'ng Kiah Kiean more than 10 years ago in 2004, when both of us took a lift from Mr Khoo Cheang Jin, a fellow artist, to visit a gallery at Sungai Patani. Both Kiah Kiean and Cheang Jin are qualified architects who are good in art. I found Kiah Kiean to be rather shy initially. However, after we got to know each other better, he took out his drawing and asked me for my opinion. I told him his artwork was good, and if he continues his journey in art, he may even have a solo exhibition at my gallery one day. Well, after so many years, my prediction has finally come true. I am proud to host his current one-man show which displays his talent in sketching Penang. This exhibition is also held in conjunction with the 25th anniversary of the opening of The Art Gallery, Penang (which started in September 1989).

I next saw him when both of us were appointed as committee members of Penang State Art Gallery in 2006. As he was already having his graphic design company, he was requested to do the design work for our Retrospective Exhibition monographs. In 2008, I was invited to guest curate Lee Joo For's Retrospective exhibition as well as edit his monograph. It was my pleasure to work with Kiah Kiean on the monograph, and I was impressed by the quality of his design work. Later, when I started my branch gallery in Kuala Lumpur, I requested him to design all the catalogues which became classier compared to previously. From then on, he designed all my subsequent books and monographs. The latest work was when he did the design work for Marshall Cavendish, Singapore which published the second edition of my Eight Pioneers of Malaysian art in September.

As far as his artworks are concerned, I marvelled at his 'quirky' sketching, with his lines dancing all over the paper to create intricate and delicate drawings of buildings, especially Penang heritage buildings. It may appear that he intentionally distorts the architecture of the buildings, but somehow, the final drawing is harmonised and the buildings become alive and dramatic. Sometimes, like Chinese ink paintings, he leaves white space all over, but the white is well placed to balance the black complex of lines, making the artwork more unique and interesting. Later, he added watercolour to some of his works which enhance the aesthetics of his works. With or without colour, I love his drawings or sketches which are all done plein air, (on the spot, outdoor).

I was so impressed with his works, that I submitted his drawing of St George's Church for Henry Butcher Art Auctioneers auction of Young Contempo, in 2012. The painting was readily accepted and sold well. In March 2014, I submitted another painting to Masterpiece auction of Malaysian Art, which also accepted it for auction and sold equally well. Yes, Kiah Kiean has come a long way since the first time we met, and only time can tell what direction his marvellous artworks will take him further. Truly, he is a talented artist who interprets building in a style uniquely his own.

























第一和二檳威大橋 FIRST & SECOND PENANG BRIDGE

















